





Ibirapuera Shopping Mall


Plaza Sul Shopping Mall

With a monthly attendance of nearly 750,000 people and 220 stores, the Plaza Sul Shopping Mall attracts those who live, study and work in the areas of Jabaquara, Jardim da Saúde, Vila Mariana, Aeroporto, Aclimação, Planalto Paulista, Ipiranga, as well as the cities of the ABCD region of Greater São Paulo.

Pátio Paulista Shopping Mall

The Pátio Paulista Shopping Mall has become a major location for São Paulo citizens to gather. In addition to the 276 stores plus more than 50 restaurants, it is well located and easy to get to, which makes it an important attraction: the mall is between Avenida Paulista and Avenida 23 de Maio and near many subway stations.



MASP (Assis Chateaubriand Art Museum of São Paulo)

The museum is internationally recognized for its collection of European art, which is one of the finest in the southern hemisphere.

Pinacoteca do Estado de São Paulo




Avenida Paulista (Paulista Avenue)




São Paulo's Market (Mercadão)

Known in São Paulo as the Mercadão, or "big market", the municipal market is a famous meeting point for residents São Paulo and one of the most visited tourist spots in the city. The historic building occupies 12,600 square meters (136,000 sq ft) in which some 300 producers and traders sell fruit, vegetables, cereals, meat, spices and diverse food products from all over the world.

Ibirapuera Park

One of the most visited and photographed city parks on Earth, Ibirapuera attracts 14.4 million visits per year. Its gardens were designed by Roberto Burle Marx and the park, which covers 390 acres, is home to a variety of historical sites with museums, concert halls and the famous marquee designed by the architect Oscar Niemeyer.
